



I WANT A SUCCESSFUL CAREER IN REAL ESTATE! HOW DO I GET STARTED?

What are the necessary steps to obtain a California Real Estate License?

1. Complete the required Real Estate License courses.
You can take these courses through correspondence (materials available from Allied Schools or from our office) to get your certificates of completion, attend a Century 21 approved Real Estate school or attend a local college.
2. Complete education requirements
Pass the state real estate exam.
Submit a DRE application with all required documents to the Dept. of Real Estate.

Will I be able to pass the test the first time?

The Dept. of Real Estate requires 3 college level Real Estate courses (Real Estate Principles & Real Estate Practices being required) to be completed before taking your license exam. Depending on where you take these courses, most schools may not provide you with materials to prepare for the state exam. Purchasing your courses through Allied does provide you with specific state exam test materials.

What does it cost?

The Premium Plus course offered by Allied Schools (available through our office or online) costs \$350.00.

How long will it take?

Each Real Estate course through Allied Schools will take a minimum of 18 days. Once you apply to take the exam, you can expect to be assigned a test date in about 6 to 8 weeks. Once you have taken the test you can get your results in 5-10 business days. Please contact the Department of Real Estate for current fee schedule.
